Opinion

We have audited the quarterly financial results of Ganga Papers India Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended 31st March, 2023 and the year to date/yearly results for the period 1st April, 2022 to 31st March, 2023 ("the Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 and 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").
